### **New Rules for Contractors**

Beginning April 22, 2010 any contractor who performs work for compensation that may disturb lead-based paint in residential, child-care, and/or educational facilities built before 1978 must be EPA certified and adhere to specific work-related guidelines that prevent lead contamination.

### **Who Should Take This Class?**

EPA's Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) Rule affects anyone who is paid to perform work in housing and child-occupied facilities built before 1978.

### **This includes:**

- Home improvement/renovation contractors
- Property managers
- Carpenters
- Painters
- Electricians
- Plumbers
- Maintenance personnel
- Potential HUD Contractors
- Any workers removing and modifying paint surfaces

### **CEET's EPA Certified Lead Renovation Training**

This 9-hour course trains contractors to comply with EPA's RRP Rule and HUD's Lead Safe Housing Rule and also covers New Jersey's Regulations on Lead Safe Work Practices. Training modules highlight containment activities, regulations, recordkeeping, health concerns pertaining to lead poisoning, and training Non-Certified Renovation Workers.

The hands-on containment and cleanup activities provide participants with the appropriate methods to limit the amount of dust created on a job site and to appropriately contain and clean up any dust that is created.
