Turnkey office, warehouse, arts, and community spaces with exposed brick walls, massive timbers, and natural light throughout.



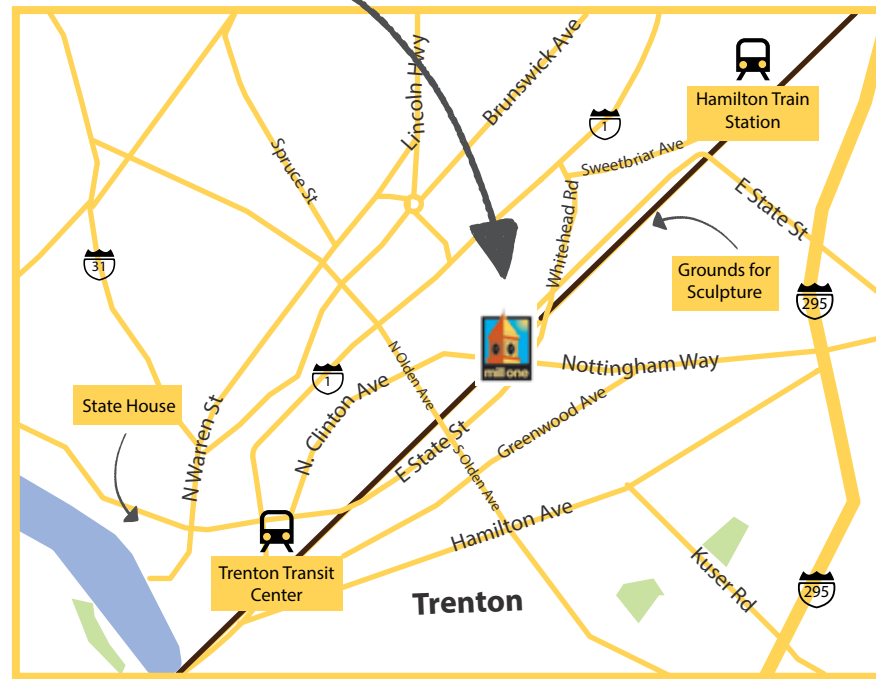

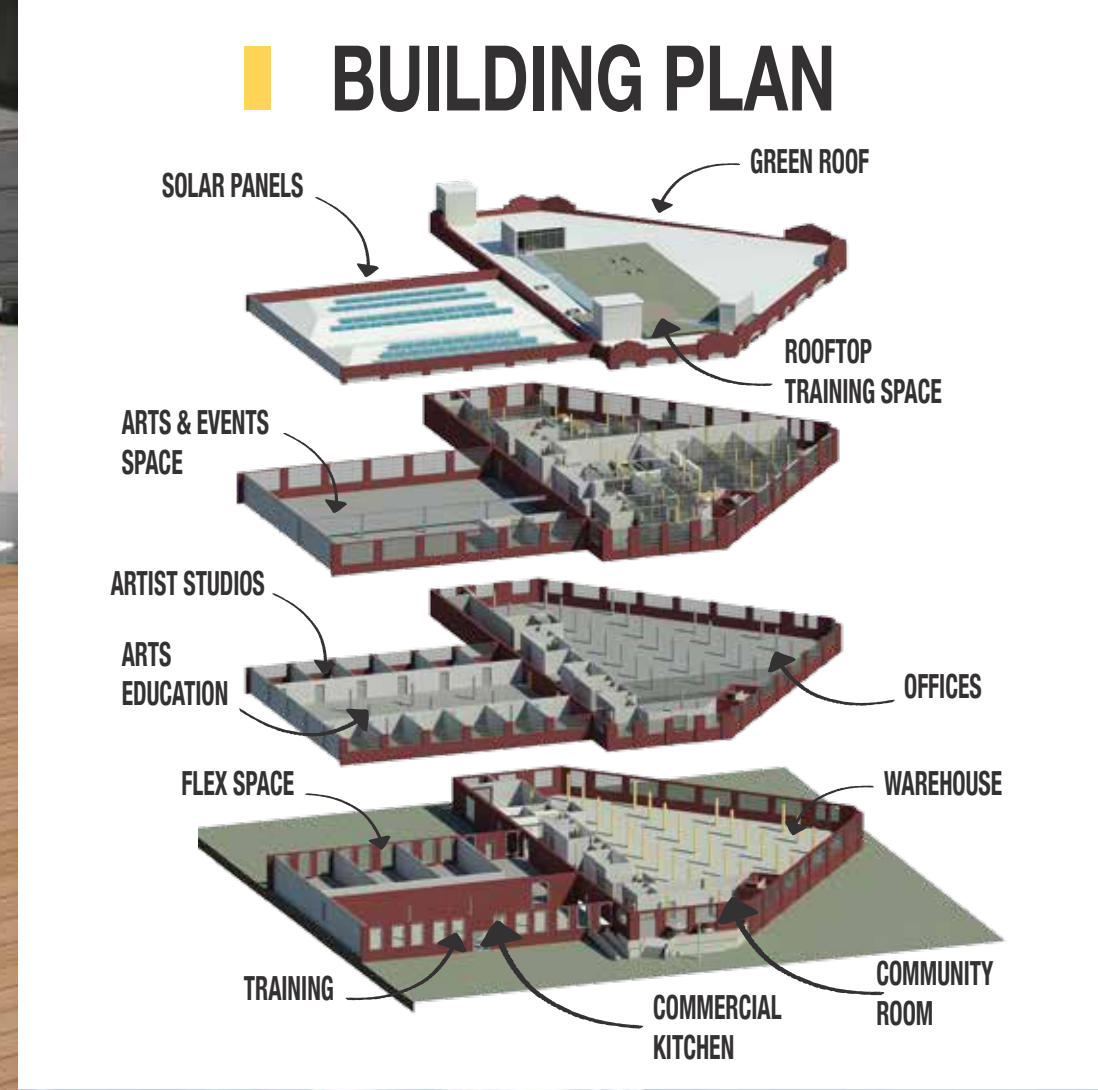
