Created in 1995, Isles Youth Institute (IYI) is an alternative school for dropouts and others who have had challenges completing traditional high school. IYI offers academic and vocational training with a strong emphasis on leadership development and civic engagement. Students participate in afterschool activities and volunteer extensively in the community. Staff works with students to help them apply to college and find employment.

IYI is encouraging youth and family members to attend the recruitment event to learn more about IYI services and sign up for the upcoming year. Dr. Gail Brooks, IYI’s Principal, states, “This event is a great opportunity for potential IYI students to talk to our staff and current students and see what IYI has to offer. If you’re curious about GED and job training opportunities, we’d love to talk to you.”

Students and families will have a chance to tour IYI, fill out applications, and interview with staff. The event is free and open to the public.
