- Assess other indoor issues that affect asthma or other health conditions.
- Give you tips on how to keep your home lead safe and healthy.

Testing takes about an hour and can be scheduled on weekends or evenings for your convenience. You may also be eligible for up to \$13,000 in home improvements at no cost to you.

If you qualify*, we may be able to:

- Replace your roof, windows, doors, interior walls damaged by moisture
- Replace unsafe stoves and refridgerators
- Provide heating system repair/replacement and energy efficiency upgrades to save you money on your heating bills

You qualify if we find lead based paint and your household income meets these annual income limits for family size:

1 - \$55.950

2 - \$63.950

3 - \$71.950

5 - \$86,300 6 - \$92,700

4 - \$79.900

If you are a landlord who rents to income qualified participants, this program is also available to you.
