Isles launched the Johnson Center for Learning & Impact to further the reach of our efforts and influence more widespread systems-change. The Johnson Center team is engaged in work designed to:

- Shape public policy through advocacy and strategic partnerships.
- Train the next generation of nonprofit leaders.
- Promote sharing of best practices and collaboration among nonprofit agencies.
- Build Isles' data and research capability.

Trenton Climate Corps provides hands-on training to community members to create pathways to green jobs.

Trenton Community Street Teams is a community-based violence intervention initiative that interrupts the cycle of violence by providing:

- Victim advocacy and support.
- Safe passage around schools.
- Community safety walks to raise awareness and connect people to needed resources.
- Public safety roundtables.

Trenton's first Re-Engagement Center works with high school students who have dropped out of school, connecting them with resources to ensure their success.

GOTrenton! is an electric vehicle transportation service that will increase mobility for low-income residents. In 2022, we:

- Secured an easily-accessible, downtown Trenton parking lot headquarters.
- Designed layouts for multiple, publicly available EV charging centers.
- Hired an operator for EV fleet service starting in 2023.

Lead Hazard Control, Energy Efficiency, and Healthy Homes

We provide home health assessments and retrofits to improve energy efficiency, remove lead-based paint hazards and improve indoor health and safety. In 2022, we:

- Conducted 221 lead and healthy homes assessments.
- Made 43 homes lead-safe.
- Improved heating systems and energy efficiency in more than 130 homes.

Housing and Financial Services (HFS)

HFS empowers people to make informed financial decisions, prepares them to purchase a home and helps them stay in that home. This year:

- We served 330 first-time homebuyers and foreclosure prevention counseling customers.
- 93 customers earned housing certificates to qualify for financial assistance.
- 34 customers purchased a first home.
- 319 people participated in financial counseling services.

Isles Youth Institute (IYI) & Youth Services

Isles continues to provide education, job training, and personal development opportunities. In 2022:

- We trained more than 50 youth in construction, CPR/First Aid, OSHA, and more.
