Isles Response to DOJ's Ruling on Trenton Police Department

Today, the U.S. Department of Justice's Civil Rights Division and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the District of New Jersey announced the results of an ongoing investigation in which they found that Trenton and Trenton Police Department engaged in conduct that deprives people of their rights under the U.S. Constitution. We want to thank the US Attorney's office for their thorough investigation. All members of the community have a right to be protected in appropriate ways, and Isles vigorously opposes the use of inappropriate force and unlawful practices.

We know that safety is critical in our city and that community members and grassroots organizations have an essential role in ensuring this. Public safety is all our responsibility, and we can effectively address safety concerns together. Isles will continue to work with the Street Teams and other committed organizations to ensure community members are part of the solution and have a platform from which they can speak and be heard.

We encourage the Trenton Police Department to work collaboratively and swiftly to implement remedial measures and look forward to ensuring our community members are appropriately supported.
